



JUBILEE 2025 – PILGRIMS OF HOPE **OPENING MASS**

The Christian life is a journey calling for moments of greater intensity to encourage and sustain hope as the constant companion that guides our steps towards the goal of our encounter with the Lord Jesus.

In May of 2024, Pope Francis announced that a Holy Year of Jubilee, entitled Jubilee 2025-Pilgrims of Hope, will open in Rome on the eve of the Nativity of the Lord, December 24, 2024, and conclude on the Epiphany of the Lord, January 6, 2026.

Jubilee 2025 promises to be a time of grace for the Universal Church. In the Archdiocese of Newark each of the parishes and the entire Catholic community-clergy, those in consecrated life, and the lay faithful-should have many opportunities to share in this grace.

Pope Francis has directed that "on Sunday, 29 December 2024, in every cathedral and cocathedral, diocesan bishops are to celebrate Holy Mass as the solemn opening of the Jubilee Year" (Spes non confundit, 6).

All of the priests, religious, and lay faithful of the Archdiocese of Newark are invited to join Cardinal Joseph W. Tobin on Sunday, December 29, 2024, the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, for the opening Mass at 12:00 Noon at the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Newark
